Sullivan County Public Health Services encourages all residents to “Dump Your Water” every Wednesday in an effort to reduce the number of mosquitoes potentially carrying Zika virus and other mosquito borne illnesses.

Dump, clean, scrub or throw out items that hold water such as:

Buckets	Planters
Tires	Toys
Pools	Flowerpots
Trash Containers
