Sewer Project Update Construction continues to progress nicely on the sewer project. I would again like to thank everyone for the patience and courtesy shown to the construction crews while they are working along the roads.

Town Pool As the summer season starts to wind down, I would like to remind everyone that the last day that the town pool will be open is August 29th.

Traffic Light The State of New York at the request of residents did a traffic survey for the light at the intersection of Rte 42 and Rte. 55 and the possibility of replacing the blinking light with a regular traffic light. At the completion of the study, it was determined there was not enough traffic to replace with a regular traffic signal. The State had two recommendations that we have requested them to proceed with (1) increasing the parking restriction on Route 55 at the intersection in front of Brenner's Law Office from the current 50 feet restriction to 150 feet to improve the sight distance; and (2) trimming of the shrubs on Route 55 in front of Brenner's Law Office, maintaining a height of 30 inches or less to prevent them from interfering with the sight distance.

We have also added a "Guide to Barn Quilts" which includes a map indicating each barn in the community that displays a barn quilt and where it is located. There are also brochures available at the Town Hall which will help guide you in locating the barn quilts which are displayed throughout the community.
