**Reminder** The Town Hall will be closed on April 2<sup>nd</sup> in observance of Good Friday.

**Burning Permit** Reminder for those who have permits: *open burning is NOT permitted from March 16<sup>th</sup> to May 14<sup>th</sup>.*

**Carbon Monoxide Alarms** The New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council has adopted a rule implementing "Amanda's Law", which *mandates the installation of carbon monoxide alarms in most dwellings in New York State.* A copy of the regulations can be obtained from the Building Department at the Town Hall in Grahamsville. These regulations went into effect on February 22, 2010.

**Census** As you know, 2010 is the year of the census and I am asking that everyone complete the census form as soon as possible and return in the envelope provided. This is important for funding for our school, towns and other government funding that our state would receive.

**Community Shred Event** The Town of Neversink together with Catskill Hudson Bank will be hosting a joint community shred event on May 22<sup>nd</sup> from 9 AM – 12:30 PM at the town hall, rain or shine. HV Shred will have a mobile shredding truck onsite where you can bring your materials and view them as they are shredded. Keep your eye out as there will be more publicity/info in the next few weeks on this valuable upcoming event.

**Dept. of Motor Vehicles** The DMV will be at the Town Hall from 10 AM to 2:30 PM on April 15<sup>th</sup>, May 13<sup>th</sup> and June 10th.

**Historian's Office** New for 2010 – Carol Smythe, Town Historian, will have designated office hours for the convenience of the public on Wednesdays from 1 PM to 4 PM for research and/or questions and Fridays 1 PM to 4 PM by appointment.

**Parks & Rec** Reminder that the Parks & Rec Office is open every Tuesday from 3-6 PM at the Town Hall. Director Jamie Brooks will be available during that time for sign-ups and to answer whatever questions you may have.

**Sewer Project Update** **The sewer project has reached final completion!** Those homeowners who are part of the extension project should have received a letter from the Town requesting you to hook-up; hook-ups must be completed by June 30, 2010. Remember you must obtain a no-fee permit from John Perrella, CEO who can be reached at 985-2262 ext. 302.

**Spring Litterpluck Day** Sullivan County has designated May 1st as Spring Litterpluck Day. Sullivan County DPW will donate trash bags for this community-based roadside cleanup event and will accept the roadside refuse and recyclables for disposal free-of-charge at the County Landfill and Transfer Stations. **Stream Management Program** The Sullivan County Soil & Water Conservation District and NYC DEP, along with cooperation from the Towns of Neversink and Denning will be developing stream management plans for the upper Rondout Creek and the East and West Branches of the Neversink River. It is through this effort that they will be looking at ways to prevent damage to property owners caused by chronic flooding, erosion problems, etc. We are happy to report that they now have a staffed office located in the Town Hall and can be reached at 985-2581.
