2020 BUDGET

Budget Officer/Bookkeeper Teri Lockhart reviewed with the Town Board the **2021 Tentative Budget**. The following changes were made: Expenses in Unallocated Ins. were reduced by \$3,000.00; Parks, Equip. & Capital Outlay were Increased by \$32,000.00; Parks, Contractual Expense were Increased by \$500.00; Youth Program, Contractual Expense were increased by \$600.00; Clearance, Demo & Rehabilitation, Equipment & Capital Outlay were increased by \$34,000.00 and State Retirement was reduced by \$2,000.00. Changing the overall Total Town & Special District Taxes to be raised by \$62,100.00 all of which is in the General Fund. The 2021 Budget will Increase by 1.42% making the Town able to stay under the States 2% Tax Cap for 2021. The Public Hearing for the 2021 Budget will be held on November 4, 2020 at 7:15 pm. The following motion was made:

A motion was made by Councilman Richard Coombe Jr., seconded by Councilman Keith Zanetti, to accept the 2021 Tentative Budget as the 2021 Preliminary Budget and to set the Public Hearing for November 4, 2020 at 7:15 pm, put to a vote and UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

VOTE: AYES 5 NAYS 0.

SUPERVISOR

1. A resident in the Town of Neversink is experiencing a **noise problem** from a neighbor. Mr. Mathews is inquiring if the Board would be willing to consider looking into a possible Noise Ordinance for the Town of Neversink. He would like to look into what other Town's in the County have in their codes. Chris does not want anything aggressive, just something that might help with noisy neighbors.
2. Supervisor Mathews is asking the Board to approve the payment of \$30,109.08 to Iron Sleeks for the deposit on the **portable ice rink** approved for purchase at the October 14th Town Board Meeting. The following motion was made:

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A motion was made by Councilman Richard Coombe Jr., seconded by Councilman Keith Zanetti approving the payment of \$30,109.08 to Iron Sleeks for a deposit on the portable ice rink, put to vote and UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.
VOTE: AYES 5 NAYS 0.

3. The **streetlights** in **Neversink** will be replaced with LED bulbs by NYSEG. **Grahamsville** has already been done by Central Hudson.
