TOWN OF NEVERSINK RESOLUTION NO. 14 of 2023 CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

An application has been duly made to the Board of the **Town of Neversink, County of Sullivan**, New York, by **Spectrum Northeast, LLC**, an indirect subsidiary of Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter"), a limited liability company organized and existing in good standing under the laws of State of Delaware doing business at 2604 Seneca Avenue, Niagara Falls, NY 14305, for the approval of a renewal agreement for Charter's cable television franchise for fifteen (15) years commencing with the date of approval by the Public Service Commission.

The franchise renewal agreement would bring the franchise into conformity with certain provisions of the Federal Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984, as amended, and certain court rulings.

A public hearing was held in the Town of Neversink, New York on June, 14 at 7:15 P.M. and notice of the hearing was published in the Democrat on May 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of the Town of Neversink finds that:

- 1. Spectrum Northeast, LLC has substantially complied with the material terms and conditions of its existing franchise and with applicable law; and
- 2. Spectrum Northeast, LLC has the financial, legal and technical ability to provide these services, facilities and equipment as set forth in its proposal attached; and
- 3. Spectrum Northeast, LLC can reasonably meet the future cable-related community needs and interests, taking into account the cost of meeting such needs and interests.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of the **Town of Neversink** hereby grants the cable television franchise of Spectrum Northeast, LLC and the **Town of Neversink** for fifteen (15) years commencing with the date of approval by the Public Service Commission and expiring fifteen (15) years hence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of the **Town of Neversink** hereby confirms acceptance of this franchise renewal agreement.

- 6. Due to the low water level in the streams, the **pool** will not be drained and refilled this year. The painting of the lap lines in the bottom of the pool will be rescheduled for this fall at the end of the pool season.
- 7. The Board discussed the **soil sample results from the Route 42 Park**. It was agreed that the turf on the fields need to be addressed. The main problem is finding the time in the calendar when the fields are not being used. One suggestion was to do it one field at a time. It was suggested to contact Tri-Valley and ask about safety procedures when adding nutrients to the fields. Chris will contact AYSO about not using field 4 this fall.
- 8. Supervisor Mathews reported to the Board on his meeting with NYS DOT concerning the **parking problem at the Route 42 Park**. After looking at all the possibilities and taking into consideration the line of site, it was DOT's recommendation that the Town continues to pursue the land swap with NYC DEP for the property across from the Park and putting in a crossway.
