• **Budget Officer Teri Lockhart** reviewed the \$69,345.00 increase in proposed Budget from 2017 to 2018, which is a 1.8% increase. It results in a \$3.00 per thousand of assessed value increase. Of the \$69,345.00, \$61,000.00 is due to the rising cost of health insurance.

**Mark McCarthy** – Mr. McCarthy takes issue with such a significant percentage increase and can't imagine there's any justification for an elected official to give themselves a double-digit raise. Mr. McCarthy left the Public Hearing immediately after his comment.
