Budget Officer Teri Lockhart and the Town Board discussed the Budget. Teri stated that the Town's \$4,279,266.00 Tax Levy for 2023 Budget is under the State-mandated 2% Tax Cap. The Tax rate will go to \$4.05 increase per thousand assessment. The 2023 Budget sees an increase in our youth program, on employee salaries and our overall Town operating expenses.

Additional topics were discussed while the Public Hearing remained open.

- Teri and the Board had a discussion that Teri will be looking into new options for investing Town of Neversink Funds.
- The \$7,500 allocated in the 2022 Budget for the playground will not be used until 2023. The funds will go to fund balance at the end of the year and will get reappropriated in 2023.
- Cher would like to pay off the balance of \$6,404.00 on the chiller with funds from the 2022 Budget. The Board was in favor.

On motion by Councilperson Richard Coombe Jr., seconded by Councilperson Keith Zanetti, put to a vote and UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED the Public Hearing was closed at 7:27 P.M.
